



## Marc Funk

Marc Funk is the Group's Chief Legal and Compliance Officer (CLO) for Lonza and has been a member of the Executive Committee since April 2012. As Group General Counsel and Board Secretary since 2009, he has been responsible not just for Legal, Compliance and Intellectual Property in the company, but also for Quality Assurance, Corporate Services for Asia, and Environment, Health and Safety.
